Your personal information

Personal information is information about an identifiable individual, such as names, addresses, email addresses and telephone numbers.

About GB Energy

GB Energy's objective is to provide a new source of local gas supply in one of Australia's oldest and most prolific gas-producing regions, the Gippsland Basin.

The gas will serve domestic markets and the reserve has the potential to support secure, reliable energy supply over many years.

The project aims to provide flexibility and efficiency to the energy market, further supporting low-emission and renewable targets over the long term.

The Project

The GB Project aims to assess the natural gas held in the Golden Beach gas field, with the potential for developing the field for gas production in the longer term.

The field is situated in Victorian state waters, approximately 4km from the shoreline. It is located between the townships of Golden Beach and Glomar Beach off the Ninety Mile Beach.

The Golden Beach field was first identified in the mid 1960's with the discovery well drilled in 1967.

The current shortage of gas in Eastern Australia provides an incentive for the field to be developed. GB Energy are planning to drill two offshore appraisal wells to further assess the characteristics of the field.

For landowners and occupiers affected by the GB Project, we may need to collect information about you and the activities that occur on your property in order to minimise the impacts of the GB Project on you and your property.

If we collect personal information from you, we will handle that information in line with the Commonwealth Privacy Act 1988 and our Privacy Policy for the GB Project.

Using personal information

Why would we collect your information?

We may collect and use your personal information to:

- Provide you with information about the GB Project;
- Assist with the design and implementation of the GB Project;
- Minimise the impacts of the GB Project on you and affected communities;
- Respond to your enquiry, feedback or complaint about the GB Project;
- Discuss other matters relating to the GB Project with you; and
- Support ongoing pipeline operations and maintenance.

Privacy

When would we collect your information?

If you are a landowner or occupier affected by the GB Project, we will collect some personal information when we make contact with you about the GB Project and when you contact us.

If you are not directly affected by the GB Project, but wish to learn more about it, we may collect your personal information when you contact us about the GB Project.

How would we use your information?

Information we collect, including during discussions with landowners and occupiers, will be used by GB Energy (VIC) Pty Ltd, its related companies and contractors for the purposes set out above. Related companies and contractors who use the information we collect may be located overseas.

We will ensure that your personal information is not disclosed without your consent for a purpose other than those set out above, except if necessary to prevent a threat to life or health, required or authorised by law or reasonably necessary to enforce a law.

Accessing our records of your information
